Why Eleventy stuck?

Next.js

- ▶ It did too much for what I wanted to achieve
- ▶ Typescript was more trouble than it was worth
- ▶ I was focusing on making the framework happy and not building my site.

Eleventy

- ▶ Simplicity – strips away the abstraction that comes from using frameworks
- ▶ Re enforced the web technology I already knew
- ▶ Made me get focus more on semantic html, SEO and accessibility
- ▶ Community
